CUSTOM ORTHOTICS & COMPRESSION THERAPY

WHAT ARE CUSTOM-MADE ORTHOTICS?

Custom-made orthotics are biomechanical devices designed to correct the alignment of the foot and ankle. They are shaped like footwear insoles and are used with shoes to improve foot pain and walking patterns. Each pair of custom made orthotics is made directly from a 3D laser scan of your foot and designed specifically to address your foot's individual needs.

Orthotics support the foot in a corrected, neutral position, allowing your feet to function within a normal range of motion. They allow for better pressure distribution to reduce and prevent foot pain and complications.

WHAT ARE COMPRESSION STOCKINGS?

Compression stockings are used to control swelling in the legs. They help improve circulation by preventing a build up of fluid in the area. Compression gently squeezes the leg muscles and vein walls to help move fluid up the leg thus improving blood flow and decreasing leg pain.
